DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FROM INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

1. A fully completed International Student Application Form (available for download from the Institute's website: [application form](#)).
2. A Turkish-language proficiency certificate showing a score of at least 55 on an examination administered by a Turkish Language Education, Application and Research Center at a university in Türkiye. Applicants who completed their undergraduate education in Türkiye must also submit a valid ALES score report.
3. For applicants to the PhD program, a minimum score of 55 in YDS, or an equivalent examination recognized by the Interuniversity Board, in a foreign language other than the applicant's native language.
4. Certified copy of passport.
5. Diploma or graduation certificate Translated into Turkish and approved by the Relevant Authorities.
6. Academic transcripts, translated into Turkish and notarized or certified by the relevant authorities.
7. Equivalency certificate approved by the competent authorities.

Note: Originals or certified copies of all aforementioned documents must be submitted to the Institute at the time of final registration. Applications submitted with incomplete or inaccurate documentation shall be considered invalid.

ASSESSMENT AND ADMISSION PRINCIPLES FOR INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

1. For admission to master's programs, the composite score will comprise 70% of the undergraduate Grade Point Average (GPA) and 30% of the Turkish language proficiency score.
2. For admission to PhD programs, the composite score will comprise 50% of the graduate GPA, 25% of the Turkish language proficiency score, and 25% of the foreign language proficiency score.
3. For international applicants who graduated from higher education institutions in Türkiye, the composite score will comprise 50% of the undergraduate GPA, 30% of the ALES score, and 20% of the Turkish language proficiency score.
4. All component scores will be converted to a 100-point scale before the composite score is calculated.
5. Applicants will be ranked according to their composite scores, and places in the relevant graduate programs will be offered in accordance with the announced quotas.

TUITION AND CONTRIBUTION FEES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- * The total tuition fee and student contribution per semester has been set at 30,000 TL.
- * Students are responsible for paying their own Social Security Institution (SGK) healthcare insurance contributions
- * All fees must be paid prior to registration, and proof of payment must be submitted to the Institute.
